We invite the public health students to contribute their invaluable experiences to this essential event.

- Social and behavioral change
- From research to policy (implementation science)
- Public health collaboration and partnership

Oral Presentations and Scientific Posters

At the first public health student's conference, we embrace diverse modes of knowledge dissemination, allowing participants to share their insights either through:

- Oral presentations or
- Scientific posters, which will be showcased during the event.

Who Can Submit an Abstract?

All the current public health students (Masters/bachelors) and recent public health graduates (graduated since January 2023) can submit an abstract.

Abstract Structure

To facilitate effective communication:

- Abstract must be original research conducted in Nepal
- Abstracts should be crafted in English
- Font type must be Arial and font size must be 11 pt.
- Keep the title concise, not exceeding 20 words
- The body of the abstract should not exceed 300 words

Your abstract should encompass four essential components:

- ➤ Introduction Objectives: Provide context for your work and clearly define the objectives of your presentation.
- ➤ **Methodology:** Offer a detailed account of the methods employed, (study design, site, participant's recruitment, data collection method, tools, techniques, ethical considerations, etc.)
- Results: Present the results of the study or project. Emphasize important and innovative aspects of your work.
- **Conclusions:** Summarize the main conclusions drawn from your research.

Please note that the use of tables, photos, and graphs is not permitted in the abstract

Validation and Registration

All submitted abstracts will undergo thorough review by the Selection Committee.

The participant capacity is restricted to 200 individuals, and selections will be made on a first-come, first-served basis. Those chosen to participate will receive email notifications regarding their attendance at the conference.

To attend the event, participants are required to register through the given registration link. Additionally, presenters (oral/poster) must submit their corresponding abstract using the provided link.



The selected abstracts will be announced through e-mail. Following the selection, the presenting author must adhere to the following guidelines for their respective presentations:

For Poster Presentation:

For consistency and ease of presentation, all posters should adhere to a standardized size of 36" width and 48" height.



For Oral Presentation:

Oral presentations are allocated a 10-minute slot, followed by a 5-minute Q&A session with the audience.

You may use PowerPoint for your presentation.

Publication

- ➤ Posters and summaries of oral presentations will be published in an electronic compilation of all the posters presented at the conference.
- > By submitting a presentation (oral or poster), authors grant consent for its publication.
